What is a Painter & Decorator?

A Painter and Decorator applies protective finishes in commercial, institutional and industrial settings. The individual prepares a variety of surfaces (*wood, masonry, drywall, plaster, concrete, synthetics, stucco and metal*) prior to the application of materials such as paint, high performance coatings, waterproofing, fireproofing, and specialty finishes.
