# Silver Linings

- The Prom is scheduled for **Thursday May 19<sup>th</sup>**, at the Ajax Convention Centre located at 550 Beck Crescent, off of Chambers Road and Salem Road.
- Tables seating selection will be available during lunch in the caf on **Monday May 9<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday May 10<sup>th</sup>**. Tables can seat between 8-10 people (no more and no less).
- Tickets will be available for pick up **Monday May 16<sup>th</sup>, and Tuesday May 17<sup>th</sup>**. Any student with a school debt will not have their ticket released until this debt is paid for in full. Please bring your student ID for ticket pickup.  
**If you miss these dates, you will be picking up your tickets in the main office.**
- Doors open at 6:00 p.m. and dinner begins at 7:00 p.m.  
The evening will come to an end at 11:30 pm.
- In order to get into Prom, students will need:
  - a ticket (will be distributed during both lunches in the Cafeteria...BRING PHOTO ID for pick up).
  - **photo identification** (student ID, driver's licence etc...)
- Students who arrive at Prom intoxicated/high or suspected of, will not be admitted, and their ticket price will **not be refunded**. In addition, smoking and vaping are not permitted at the Prom. Students and their possessions will be searched prior to admittance to prom, and any vapes or other contraband items will be confiscated at the door.
- Prom is a private school event, supervised by school staff, security guards and police officers. The same rules and expectations, and code of conduct of the school apply to you and guests at Prom.
- Students will be admitted to the Prom once and only once. When you leave, no matter what the reason or time, you will not be re-admitted. **No exceptions!**
- Parties, which continue after the Prom is over, **ARE NOT** endorsed by Notre Dame C.S.S.

Location: The Embassy Church, 416 Taunton Rd., Oshawa

Graduates are to arrive at the venue by 2:00 pm. Each grad should be wearing the gown, cap and stole, with the tassel hanging on the LEFT side of the cap. Caps and gowns are not to be altered in ANY way. Modified caps and gowns will not be permitted to be worn during the ceremony. Grads will gather in the church hall.

Encourage your guests to carpool where possible. The Church has advised us to park only in the Church lot as there is a possibility of being ticketed if you park in other businesses parking lots. There is no street parking in the area.

A professional photographer will be at the ceremony taking pictures of each grad as he or she receives a diploma. For safety reasons, guests will not be allowed to come to the stage area to take photos during the ceremony.
