

Online Course Selection with

myBlueprint

STEP 1 Log into



- → Go to your DCDSB Launchpad and click the myBlueprint icon OR
- → Go to notredame.dcdsb.ca → Click Programs and Services → Click Guidance → Click Secondary Pathway Planning → Under the heading Use myBlueprint for Course Selection, click myBlueprint
- **STEP 2** From your Dashboard, scroll down and click <u>Official High School Plan</u> OR choose <u>High School</u> from the left navigation menu.
 - → The Courses tab allows you to view all of the courses offered at ND
 - → The Plan tab allows you to plan and choose courses

STEP 3 Add courses for next year.

- → in High School Planner, click + [Course]
- → in the Course Selection and Details screen, explore the available courses
- → click Add Course when you find the course you want

HINT: The Graduation Indicator will help you keep track of your progress towards graduation. Click View Progress for a list of specific graduation requirements.

STEP 4 Review your selections when you are ready to submit your courses.

- → click the Review Course Selections and give your course selection one final check
- → use the "Add Comments" section to explain any issues/flags on your course selection submission (ie. taking prerequisites or compulsory courses in summer/night school)

STEP 5 Submit Courses

- → carefully review the **Details** page to ensure that (1) you are meeting the requirements for the courses you have selected, and (2) that the courses that appear are correct
- → click on Submit Course Selections
- → You will NOT be able to modify your course selections once they are submitted

STEP 6 Print the Sign-Off Sheet

- → after submitting your course selections, click Print Sign-Off Sheet at the top right
- → print and return signed on the collection day
- → you can also access the sign-off sheet from the High School planner; if it doesn't show after you've clicked the Print Sign-Off Sheet button, check the pop-up blocker settings for your web browser

ADDITIONAL APPLICATIONS:

The following courses require an application to be submitted with course selection.

- Co-op (COP2O or COP4O)
- Peer Tutoring (IDC4U2)
- Step Program (GWL301 & GWL308)

Fitness and Recreation Leadership (PLF4M3)

Applications can be printed by clicking Course Selection Resources in myBlueprint or on the Notre Dame website and hard copies are available in Guidance.

- → from your Dashboard, click Not returning next year? which appears in the High School Progress box
- ightarrow select the option that suits your pathway
- → click Confirm
- → click Print Sign-Off Sheet at the top right
- → print and return signed on the collection day
